1. Board of Public Works and Safety, City of Muncie, State of Indiana, met in the City Hall Auditorium, at 9:00 A.M.
2. **Members Present:** John Quirk, Roger Overbey, Bobbie Clemens
3. **Minutes:** Bobbie Clemens moved to amend minutes from the July 12th, 2017 meeting. Roger Overbey provided the second. Motion passed by voice vote.
4. **Register of Claims:**

Arron Kidder, Mayor's Office presented the **BOW EFT Payment** dated **7/12/17** there is **1 Record** for a total amount of **\$96,820.40** IU Health Plans nothing unusual within this claim. Roger Overbey moved to approve EFT payment as presented. Bobbie Clemens provided the second. Motion passed by voice vote.

Arron Kidder, Mayor's Office presented the **BOW EFT Payments** dated **7/17/17** there is **2 Records** for a total amount of **\$39,375.73** Regions Bank, Birmingham Al \$37,615.63 Bank Fees, Muncie Meds/Canarx Serv \$1,760.10 Prescription Claims nothing unusual within this claim. I would recommend the Board accept Shroyer Bros. bid for set #9 for \$38,930.00 that was the low bid. And I would also recommend that the board accept Shroyer Bros. bid for set #10 for \$85,740.00 and that was the only bid. Roger Overbey moved to accept Shroyer Bros. for both Set #9 and Set #10 as recommended by Zane Bishop. Bobbie Clemens provided the second. Motion passed by voice vote.

Dick Weigel, HWC Engineering the two quotes that we got on package A, basically ADA items we have looked over these bids. Harvey has been out and seen both of these systems at Parks and talked to people about maintenance of mats and chairs. The AccessRec bid which was slightly less had less footage of mat in their quote than what we had in our documents that were submitted as specs. They had 125' versus 132 foot and they also only manufactured 6' wide instead of 6 1/2' wide which is what we specified. The Deschamps did meet what was specked. Dick Weigel, HWC Engineering and Harvey Wright looked over the bids and found that Deschamps Mat System met our specifications and recommended the Board to accept bid from Deschamps Mat System in the amount of \$12,337.86 Bobbie Clemens moved to accept Bid from Deschamps Mat System as recommended by Dick Weigel and Harvey Wright. Roger Overbey provided the second. Motion passed by voice vote.
