4. **Approval of Minutes from April 10th, 2019 meetings:** President Overbey entertained a motion to approve minutes as printed. Rick Lorrison moved to approve April 10th, 2019 minutes as printed. Bobbie Clemens provided the second. Motion passed by voice vote.

**7. Procession Application from Tribute to Indiana's Military Fallen Heroes and Their Families "Indiana's Run for the Fallen:**

Don Finnegan is requesting a procession to honor the 488 veterans that have fallen from the war on terror. To honor they stop for 90 seconds to read each soldier name, rank, and branch of service while carrying the flag stopping a total of 145 over 3 days. This event stretches from Fort Wayne to Indianapolis passing through 9 counties. The actual event will take place on May 10<sup>th</sup> through the 13<sup>th</sup> for 3 days and 140 Miles. This procession will take place in the City limits on May 11<sup>th</sup>, 2019 from 12:00 PM to 1:30 PM starting at St Rd 3 from Riggins to Broadway - Broadway to Wysor - Wysor to Walnut - Walnut to Main - Main to Kilgore ending at the YOC (3700 W Kilgore Ave). This even will be police lead. (Approval by Joe Winkle, Muncie Chief of Police, Eddie Bell, Muncie Fire Chief) President Overbey entertained a motion approve the procession application. Rick Lorrison moved to approve the procession. Bobbie Clemens provided the second. Motion passed by voice vote.

**8. Mayor Dennis Tyler Money for AAU Jerseys**

Mayor Tyler is requesting the board to approve the purchase order for money for precipitation Jerseys for AAU, Summer League, and Fall league basketball programs for a total of \$495.00.
