4. **Approval of the September 18, 2019 Minutes:** President Overbey entertained a motion to approve. Rick Lorrison moved to approve the minutes as presented. Bobbie Clemens provided the second. Motion passed by voice vote.

5. **Register of Claims:**

Kevin Nemyer, City Controller presented the **Board of Works Special Request Check Date 9/20/2019** there is **1 Record** for a total amount of **\$3,276.84** for Rachel A. Clark. Kevin claims nothing unusual within this claim. President Overbey entertained a motion to approve. Rick Lorrison moved to approve Board of Works Special Request payment as presented. Bobbie Clemens provided the second. Motion passed by voice vote.

Duke Campbell, Superintendent Department of Public Works came forward and commented that Community Development has a little bit of different rules than we do, I have been asked numerous times why we hadn't put one out, this is very reason why we sitting here today. I have contacted the competitors and bigger companies they are all so busy on interstate work and state work they were not interested in putting a competitive bid in. They said they could throw a number in but they would not be able to do the bidding and this has been going on since June or July. I have been working if Brad and we thought we could at least two bids and having said that everybody is busy they are committed to all the infrastructure dollars from the Federal to the State and local you can't find enough workers to cover all these jobs, which is a good thing for economy. The money he has committed will stay and not go anywhere else. whether it be sometime this fall for April of 2020.

Brad King reported that Community Development will be re-advertising for infrastructure paving at various locations. President Overbey entertained a motion. Rick Lorrison moved to return bid to E & B Paving to be resubmitted at a later date. Bobbie Clemens provided the second. Motion passed by voice vote.

8. **Adjournment:** There being no further business President Overbey entertained a motion. Rick Lorrison moved to adjourn meeting, meeting adjourned at 9:13 a.m. Bobbie Clemens provided the second. Motion passed by voice vote.
