

9. **Road Safe Traffic System requesting approval to close Nichols Avenue Norfolk & Southern Railroad crossing bet. Godman & White River Blvd:** Duke Campbell, Superintendent Department of Public Works came forward to present the closure of Nichols Avenue between Godman & White River from July 7<sup>th</sup>, 2014 until July 17, 2014 for a total replacement. While they are there I would like to see them remove the spur line across Nichols Avenue which is no longer being used since Swartz Paper closed. Duke has no objection to the road closure. Roger Overbey moved to approve the Nichols Avenue closure as recommended by Duke Campbell. David Miller provided the second. Motion passed by voice vote.
10. **Road Safe Traffic System requesting approval to close Morrison Road Norfolk & Southern Railroad crossing bet. Jackson & Garver:** Duke Campbell, Superintendent Department of Public Works came forward to present the closure of S. Morrison Road between W. Jackson & Garver from July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2014 until July 21<sup>st</sup>, 2014 for a total replacement. Duke has no objection to the road closure. Linda has a better communication line with them now more than ever. Roger Overbey moved to approve Morrison Road closure as recommended by Duke Campbell. David Miller provided the second. Motion passed by voice vote.
