### 6. Superintendent's report:

Given by Harvey Wright Superintendent of Parks Dept.

Harvey spoke on Richard Rosco's passing. The Mayor and Park employees went to his viewing. Harvey also went to see His wife and daughters at their home to make sure they were doing ok and had everything they needed. He worked for P.C.R. and the Parks dept. for many yrs. Harvey wants us all to remember his family in their thoughts and prayers in the next coming weeks.

Piers at P.C.R. Harvey and Matt just got back this week from Dale hollow and Cumberland checking on new piers that float in water. You don't have to take them out of the water which will save money because we won't pay overtime for getting them out and in to the water. Harvey has found two different kinds of floating piers that will not freeze in cold weather. We will be applying through the D. N. R. and other agency's for the financing of them not a grant. We can save 120 to 130 thousand dollars a year by going to the new piers. Gist Reservoir has these piers and they do not puncher or rip when the ice hits them. Harvey also will know more after talking to the sales man for the new piers as far as which ones to pick from. A steel frame pier or a full floating pier

that sits three inches into the water. Bev. asked what the piers are made of. Harvey said they are made of the same material as an ice tray in your freezer except a little thicker.

**A.** Update on Tuhey pool and P.C.R. beach.

We are very proud of the money we saved this year. Pools are usually a money pit.

They don't make money. This is the lowest we have every been in seven years. Of this administration in office. We lost sixteen thousand dollars. Before it was from forty to ninety thousand dollars we have lost in the past. Last year was the first year the Parks dept. took P.C.R. over. We lost about twenty three thousand last year. This year, sixteen thousand is all we lost. A great improvement from years past. Bruce Reynolds asked to what do we contribute to this. Too many employees and poor management.

Concessions was twenty six thousand eight hundred and twenty six dollars. It beat last years by twenty eight hundred dollars. It continues to climb. Chemicals eats us up at Tuhey pool. They run about eleven thousand dollars a month at Tuhey pool. The hotter it is the more we use. P.C.R. there expense is labor. Life guards and concession workers.

The labor cost was thirty two thousand nine hundred and seventy dollars. Concession supplies was forty six o four. The concessions at P.C. R. was eighty six sixty three. They don't have the attendance Tuhey has. P.C.R. attendance was fifteen thousand and Tuhey was around seventy three thousand. Hannah George and Ashley both did a great job this year by helping with the budget. We didn't have to get bailed out of debt by the council for money this year. Bev asked if there was a way to make more money with the pool at the beach and Harvey stated there is no way. We would be the only ones making money in Indiana as far as pools go. We cut prices every way possible.


