

# Muncie Park & Recreation Board Meeting

Feb. 6, 2019 6p.m.

1. President, Beverly Kelley called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Ms. Kelley asked everyone to stand for the pledge of allegiance.

2. **Election of Park Board Officers:** Mark Ervin nominated Yolanda Carey for President of Park Board. With no other nominations Yolanda Carey has been elected President of the Muncie Park Board. Yolanda Carey accepted. Nominations for vice Pres. Mark nominated Beverly Kelley for vice Pres. Yolanda Second. Vote was taken and it was unanimous. Bev Kelley accepted. Beverly Kelley is vice Pres.

3. **Roll Call** – Present was Mark Ervin, Beverly Kelley vice Pres, Yolanda Carey Pres. Absent were Brue Reynolds, Adrian Leavell.

4. **Approval of the November Board Meeting Minutes** was so moved by Beverly Kelley seconded by Mark Ervin. Motion carried.

5. **The Superintendent's Report** was given by Harvey Wright.

Matt walker is the working Forman of the Parks /P. C. R. and anything that pertains to P. C. needs to go through him first. The only time I need to get involved in thing at P. C. is planning sessions and any changes. Updated repairs and if anything can't be resolved.

We are repairing and repainting old piers and walk boards repaired and painted.

We have the approval of ten new piers that float for trial bases. We will receive them third week of Feb. some time. We will leave the new floating piers in this next winter to see how they react to our weather which will be a cost saver. Not having to take the piers in and out of water. We may save around a hundred and twenty to a hundred and thirty dollars a year.

I have three employees from Parks putting in insulation and interior walls in the Community building at the campground area.

Matt and I are in the process of getting a grant from a company to build a new lodge at P. C. It would be for rent to the public. I would have a kitchenette. Used for sheriffs camp, Camp P.C. for D.& R. classes. Hopefully we will get that done soon.

The employees in the Parks are repairing the bleachers and benches. After they fix them they will paint them. The mechanic is checking all mowers and equipment to make sure when we start mowing in the spring we will be ready. Hopefully weather permitting early April.

We are in the process of removing six flag poles in Thomas Park which are leaning and broke. We are replacing them with new poles Ok'd by the Board of Works this morning.

Six sixty foot long light poles for the lights at Thomas Park will be putting them up before baseball season starts. They are LED lighting.


I graduated from Ball State University in 1971, soon after signing a contract to teach in the Ft Wayne Community Schools system. However, thanks to the efforts and support of Dr. Sam Abrams who was the Superintendent of the Muncie Schools system at that time, I sent a letter of regret back to the Superintendent of the Ft Wayne Schools and signed a teaching and coaching two sport contract at Muncie Northside High School.

I believe Andy was not only enrolled in my class room, but also a distance runner on the track team. I remember him as being an active good student willing to achieve any tasks placed before him. Although quiet in his deliberations, he worked hard to excel in the classroom and on the track team.

Andy and I remained friends for many years after my leaving the Muncie Schools and accepting an Administrative position at Ball State University as Assistant Director Of Admissions, later an Academic Advisor and an Adjunct Faculty representing the department of Fitness And Wellness, all the while having the opportunity to meet his mother and father and his immediate family, becoming aware of his position in the family owned Munson Auto Dealership.

Years later, Andy became very friendly and respectful to Mrs Lillian Dunn who was for many years the Director of The Madison Street Center. Not only did Mrs Dunn purchase two automobiles from Andy at different times, I believe, but he was diligent and responsible in the upkeep of her autos and she truly appreciated his kindness all the while. That alone and with no hesitation allows me to offer my support for the naming of the Frisbee Course in his honor.
