

Ordinance No. 2-20



**An ordinance to amend the deposit recipient accounts for Ordinance 44-19
of the City of Muncie Code.**

WHEREAS, the City of Muncie and the members of the City Council, approved the fee schedule for fire protection services and now amend the recipient accounts to read as follows, and,
WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Muncie now desires to make certain amendments to Ordinance 44-19

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MUNCIE THAT:

1. Section 1 of ordinance 44-19 shall now read:

“There is hereby established the fee schedule for collection of user fees as set out by Delaware County EMS Ordinance of Fee Schedule, Ordinance 2014-024, which currently is being used by all ambulance providers when billing citizens within the City of Muncie for the use of those services. Such funds collected shall be deposited into two accounts with 50% going into General Fund 101 and 50% going into Center Township Revenue Fund 104.”

2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage by the Common Council and signature of the Mayor or override of his veto.


