Requirements to be considered for appointment to MVP

To qualify for the initiative the following criteria must be met:

- A Veteran* who has served on active service*
- Currently enrolled and attending, as a full-time student, (verified by BSU) (defined by VA) the entire summer session
- Currently enrolled as a full-time student (verified by BSU) (defined by VA) for the following fall semester

Eliminating criteria*

- ROTC, Dependent or other recipient of benefits not deemed as a Veteran
- Traditional College student without Veteran affiliation
- Less than full time (verified by BSU) (defined by VA) anytime during the summer or fall session
- Graduated in the spring semester or will graduate in the summer session and will not return to school for the summer and fall sessions

For the purpose of this program, full time is defined as follows:

- Summer session is 9-12 hours for the entire summer session (Undergraduate)
- Fall semester is 12 hours (Undergraduate)
- Graduate Student's enrollment verified by college

Active service means full-time service, other than active duty for training, as a member of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, and Coast Guard. (va.gov)

A "Veteran" is defined as a person who

- served in the active military, naval or air service, and
- was discharged or released under conditions other than dishonorable.

"Active service" is defined as

- *active duty*, or
- any period of *active duty for training* during which a person is disabled or dies from a disease or injury incurred or aggravated in the line of duty, or
 - an acute myocardial infarction, a cardiac arrest, or a cerebrovascular accident while proceeding directly to, or returning directly from, a period of active duty for training, or
- any period of *inactive duty training* during which a person is disabled or dies from an injury incurred or aggravated in the line of duty, or
 - acute myocardial infarction, a cardiac arrest, or a cerebrovascular accident that occurred during such training or while proceeding directly to, or returning directly from, such training.

*In the event that not all MVP vacancies are filled with Veterans, the City may use the following Tier system for eligibility:

Tier 1 – Veterans (As defined by City)

Tier 2 – Dependents of Veterans. Those who receive the GI Bill entitlement from their parents

Tier 3 – ROTC or any other military associated person who do not receive benefits.

Example:

City has 25 vacancies for MVP and of those 25, only 24 veterans (Tier 1) apply. Consideration will then be given to Tier 2 and Tier 3. If a dependent (Tier 2) who is receiving GI Bill benefits and an ROTC candidate (Tier 3) apply, the position will be awarded to the dependent. If the dependent rejects the offer, the ROTC candidate will be offered the position.
