

ADOPT-A-STREET TREE PROGRAM



The Adopt-a-Street Tree Program is a partnership between homeowner residents and the city of Muncie to help restore and replant city street trees. Residents can order a 1.5”- 2” inch trunk diameter tree to be planted in the right of way public parkway in front of their home if it is 4 feet or wider.

The Muncie Urban Forester will deliver the tree free of charge. The homeowners is responsible for planting, mulching, watering, and staking of the tree. Homeowners are responsible for the adoption of the tree and its ongoing maintenance which includes: watering, mulching, minor pruning, etc. The City of Muncie will maintain ownership of the tree.

Homeowners also have the option of having the tree planted on the opposite side of the sidewalk, but would have to assume all responsibility for its subsequent upkeep and ownership.
