The Muncie Urban Forestry Committee and the Muncie Parks Department is seeking assistance to help with the cutting down of City owned Ash trees that are dead and effected by the invasive Emerald Ash Borer (EAB). The City of Muncie owns over 1,000 public Ash Trees and many of them have been destroyed by the EAB, and have become dangerous and hazardous trees.

We are seeking the assistance of licensed, insured and bonded tree professional companies that would be willing to donate a day of cutting down dead Ash Trees this winter, and the Muncie Parks Department will pick up the wood. All licensed tree professional companies that donate a day will have their annual Tree License Fee waived for 2016.

Your assistance would be greatly appreciated by the citizens of Muncie and the Muncie Urban Forestry Committee, and would help us keep our city clean and safe for our families to live and enjoy!
